#### THE SEASON OF LENT

On Wed. March 5th, we will hold a special Ash Wednesday service to open the season of Lent. Lent is the 40 days (not including Sundays) from Ash Wednesday to the Saturday before Easter.

Many often focus on this time period to grow closer to God and prepare our hearts in anticipation of what is to come Easter weekend. Some choose to fast to allow more time to spend in prayer or reflection, others may choose to give up something like going out to eat or limiting shopping using that money to donate to a worthy cause. They take some extra time to serve the church or another local mission as a reminder of Jesus' sacrifice.

Whatever you choose, we hope this time as we reflect on what Jesus did at the cross enables you to grow into a deeper relationship with the Father and the Son.



Brothers and Sisters,

We are in our third month, the month that begins the Christian season of Lent, Saint Patrick's Day, and Spring (March 20). If you are like me this is one of my favorite seasons. It is a time of searching, renewal, and expectation.



The passage that comes to mind for me today is Luke 15:1-7
Jesus shares the parable about a man who has 100 sheep and one goes missing. Jesus asks, "what will he do?" Then He says will he not go and search until he finds that one sheep? The story continues with once found the man will joyfully

carrying it home on his shoulders.

I think this is perhaps one of my favorite images of Jesus carrying us on His shoulders to bring us home to the flock, and folks, there is so much more because then Jesus says,

"In the same way, there is more joy in heaven over one lost sinner who repents and returns to God than over ninety-nine others who are righteous and haven't strayed away!"

This teaching always brings tears to my eyes because I see faces of people I love who have spiritually been carried home on God's shoulders. People I know who were living without hope, held in the shackles of sin and lost to eternity. Praise the Lord for loving us sinners!

As we travel through Lent ask God to help us remember where we were before Christ forgave us. Let God remind you of how far you have come and let Him show you something new that He wants to clean up


# **Looking Ahead to Easter**
